Trying desperately just find something to eat is top priority to them. **For nearly 30 years, Juanita and I, along with the help of our partners, try to do as much as we can to help these children have a better life.** When you see the children on the streets begging for help it breaks your heart. Many young girls are put there by parents to become prostitutes to bring money into the home so they can survive. We see boys as young as 5 years old filling holes in the road hoping some motorist will stop and give them a few cents so they can eat, and others who go to through garbage dumps to find food. **If this sounds unreal to you, I'm here to tell you it is not. It and worse things are happening every day.**



God spoke a Word to me many years ago in the country of Costa Rica **that if we were to reach a nation we must win the children.** He began then to change my direction to not only preach the Gospel but to demonstrate it to the world. As many of you know we have done as much as we can to alleviate the suffering of people in many nations, but it is Nicaragua and Guatemala that we have given so much of our lives and money to spread the Good News that Jesus loves us.





Every year we send children to school daily, feed, provide medical and dental help, clothes, shoes and also at this special time of the year gifts for each child for Christmas. This year is no different. ***This December we will spend time in Nicaragua for the school graduation, the special banquet for the parents of the graduates and our goal this year is to give gifts to at least 1500 children whether they are students of our school or attend our churches or not.*** We want to take away as much of the suffering these children as we can by giving them a day of fun, games, and gifts.

We have not increased our cost of gifts for our sponsors for many years and we are not going to again this year. If you can give more than the \$10 per gift we could certainly use it wisely. ***I want to challenge you that have churches to receive special offerings for this project, or if you have a business to invest a generous amount to help the children have a beautiful Christmas.*** As a family you may want to pool your resources and give a gift for each member of your family.
